

Types of Tutors at The Learning Center

Math/Stats Tutors: Assist students with 1000- and 2000-level MATH/STAT content (i.e. Algebra, Calculus, Stats).

Science Tutors: Assist students with 1000- and 2000-level SCIENCE content (i.e. Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, Physics).

Writing Coaches: Assist students in developing mastery and confidence with all phases of the writing process, including planning, drafting, revising, proofreading, avoiding plagiarism, and applying citation styles, especially APA.

Business Tutors: Analytics, Decision Analytics, Principles of Macroeconomics, Principles of Financial Accounting, Introduction to Information Systems).

Academic Coaches/Specialty Tutors: Assist students with general academic support (i.e., time management, study strategies, reading textbooks, test preparation) and serve as discipline/course-specific tutors (i.e.) Computer Science, French, Geography, Public Speaking, Spanish, etc.). Academic Coaches also work at the welcome desk to assist students with questions and referrals regarding our services.

Peer-Led Undergraduate Support (PLUS) Teaching Assistants: Assist students as course-embedded teaching assistants for various classes. PLUS teaching assistants attend and facilitate activities in an assigned class, meet weekly with host instructor, and host weekly study sessions.
